VIETNAM IS GRADUALLY ELIMINATING SINGLE-USE PLASTIC

Each year, Vietnam generates around **1.8 million tons of plastic waste**, ranking among the top 20 largest polluters and exceeding the global average.

Vietnam is committed to taking strong action and following a roadmap with a vision towards 2030 to minimize plastic waste. Accordingly, **the production and import of non-biodegradable plastic bags will be halted starting January 1, 2026.**
