### FROM JANUARY 1, 2025

#### FAILURE TO SORT WASTE WILL RESULTS IN FINES OF UP TO 1 MILLION VND

According to **Article 75**, Clause 1 of the 2020 Environmental Protection Law, effective **January 1, 2025**, household and individual solid waste must be sorted according to the following principles:

- Reusable and recyclable solid waste
- Organic waste (food waste)
- Other household solid waste

Households and individuals who fail to sort waste will be subject to fines ranging from 500,000 VND to 1 million VND, as stipulated in Government Decree 45/2022/ND-CP.
